- Master the content of program lesson plans
- Familiarize yourself with all guest services at SVPH
- Familiarize yourself with natural landscape and resources of SVPH
- Assist in the implementation of special events and programs as needed
- Open and close historic buildings and exhibits as assigned, meeting standards of museum practice set forth by Shaker Village

- Staff Front Entrance booth and welcome all guests to property; perform basic transactions for property usage
